

membership, the Chapter membership can instruct its Delegation to take a position for or against a measure expected to come before the Convention, or to vote for certain candidates. The Delegates are free to vote as they see fit except where an instruction has been given; but a Chapter can, by instructing its Delegation, bind it to vote as a unit (that is, to cast all of its votes in accord with the decision of the majority of the Delegation) on all issues, on a particular class of business, or on certain matters to be acted on by the Convention.
